"Feed My People"



Since 2016, Home Moravian Church members and the Moravian Church in Albania have partnered to provide food supplements to 46 families in extreme poverty in Bathore. The cost to feed a family is approximately \$42.00 per month or \$500.00 per year.

The food package includes flour, sugar, pasta, rice, beans, cooking oil, salt, soap, and detergent. Albanian Moravians purchase and distribute the food to each family. Many who receive the food now attend the worship services and several have been baptized.

The Moravian Church in Albania has grown to six congregations spread throughout the country. The Reverend Dena Grillo Fortuzi, a 2022 graduate from the Moravian Seminary in Pennsylvania and the first native-born ordained minister, pastors all six congregations plus oversees the food distribution project in Bathore. Four members of Home Church and Bishop Sam Gray visited Albania and witnessed firsthand the remarkable ministry in Albania. The Moravian Church in Albania sends quarterly reports and yearly audits documenting their stewardship of the funds received.

We are grateful for those who have contributed over the years and invite others to help support this ministry. Please consider answering God's call to "Feed My People" by writing a check to Home Moravian Church with Bathore in the memo line.

This year Art for Albania returns on October 11 and will be held as before in the Salem Fine Arts Center. The planners hope also that Home Church members will donate existing work from their personal collections. If you have art that you would be willing to contribute to Art for Albania, be assured that the sale of your donated work will benefit struggling Moravian ministries in Albania and the people they serve.
